The sports Grant is used to ensure an increase in physical education, active lifestyles and sports for all primary aged students. As a new school, this year's funding has mainly been used for PE equipment and additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport across the primary phase. Sadly, due to Covid-19 and the school closures, local sporting competitions and competitions with other schools were cancelled.

All of our students are taught PE by subject specialists from the secondary phase at King's Academy Binfield as well as class teachers.

How the Sports Grant has be Spent at KAO 2019-2020

- Playground trim trail (to be fitted September 2020) to increase physical activity during outside play times. £6,595.14
- The purchasing of equipment to support with effective teaching KS1
 - Racket and balls skills kit £160
 - Rainbow wave £34
 - Beanbags £19.99
 - Parachute £23.99
- The purchasing of equipment to be used at playtimes
 - Foam balls £32.14
 - Connected balance steps £42.95
- Equipment to support children with specific needs
 - Balance kit £110.00
 - Stilts £23.94
- Forest school equipment £579.86

How will the remaining grant be spent?

- Further age appropriate PE equipment as our eldest children move through school

- Netball posts
- Football Goal posts
- Tennis nets and equipment
- Sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when specialist teachers are not teaching the lesson
- Extra curricular activities lead by local sports organisation
- CPD for all
- Competitions
- Medals and trophies for inter-house and inter-form competitions

Currently we do not have any children taking part in swimming, however this will become part of our curriculum for children in Year 4 and Year 6.

Impact of Funding

Increased physical activity intensity levels within core curriculum lessons. Increased physical activity before school, at break times and afterschool through a combination of new fixed playground equipment and loose equipment. Secondary PE specialists teach all children so they get quality, specialist teaching from the start.
