Attendance Matters

Our expectation of **all**: 97+%

97%	=	3.5 days missed in total
95%	=	8 days missed in total or 1 week and 3 days
90%	=	16 days missed in total or 3 weeks and 1 day
85%	=	24 days missed in total or 4 weeks and 4 days
80%	=	32 days missed in total or 6 weeks and 2 days

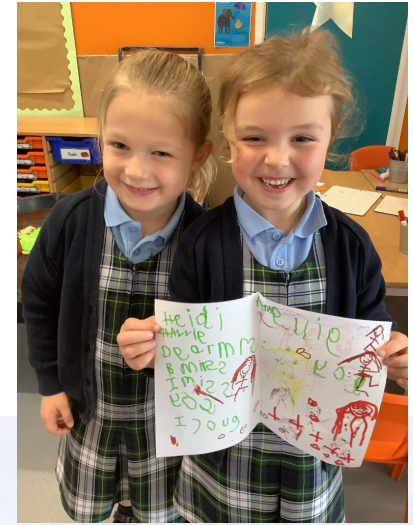
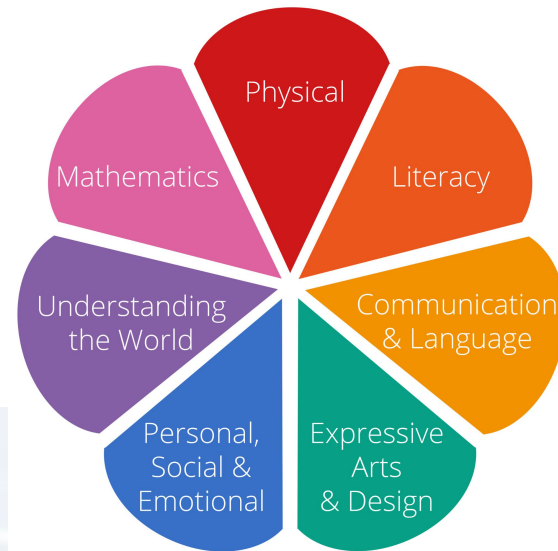

Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)

- Wonderful outside Space. Get outside as much as possible!
- Free flow between classroom and garden area.
- Lots of play and lots of talk!
- Continuous play based provision with adult led groups.
- Rich learning experiences that motivate the children and help develop their knowledge, skills, independence and resilience.
- DARE values woven into all we do
- Celebrate diversity
- Visitors to enhance learning.
- Prior to beginning school: Stay and play sessions, home visit and will speak to pre-schools.



SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities)

- Mrs Jones- SENDCO
- We will work with information gathered from home visits and current pre-schools prior to your child beginning school.
- Early identification of needs, will work with parents and referrals made if needed.
- Assess, plan, do, review model to ensure your child is reaching their potential
- Adaptive teaching within the classroom as far as possible
- Focus on a truly inclusive ethos in all aspects of the curriculum

Wrap Around Care - Funtastic Kids

- Activities during the club will include: games, arts and craft and outdoor play.
- Breakfast club 07:30-08:30 includes breakfast £5.40.
- After school club from 3:30-4:30 without tea £7.00.
- After a school club from 4:15-6:00 with tea £7.40.
- From end of school day at 3:30-6:00 with tea £12.50.
- 10% sibling discount. Contracts or ad hoc places available. All sessions include a healthy snack.

Transition to KAB in Y7

- From KAB primary it is direct - unless parents wish for an alternative secondary school
- KAO is officially a separate school with a separate DFE Number
- In Y6, KAO parents will need to apply for a place
- A criterion has been consulted upon and was successfully added to admissions policy for the 2024 intake (the first year there was a Y6 cohort) to include priority 'for children transferring to Year 7 and attending the linked primary academy, King's Academy Oakwood'
